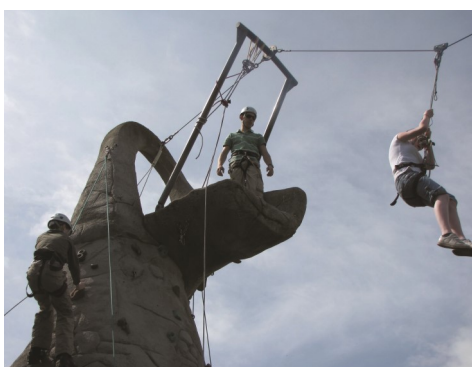

Extras:

Bedding - Sheets, pillows and pillowcases are provided for all children. Up to 7 adults will also be provided with duvets also. When requesting duvets for children, please select "bedding required" when booking. **(£2/person)**

Campfires - The Horstead Centre's Instructors can run a fun and interactive campfire for your group. Alternatively we can provide you with dry, seasoned firewood to run your own. **(£66 or £36/group)**

Longer Activities and Environmental Education - The Horstead Centre have developed a range of longer, more adventurous activities *and* curriculum-linked Environmental Education sessions. These include: full and half-day canoe trips, river flow-rate and profile surveys, species identification and animal tracks and signs. **Prices available on request.**

Room or Venue Hire - The Horstead Centre is an excellent venue for your training, function, party, or event. We have spacious lounges and conference facilities. We can cater for all dietary requirements. **Prices and availability on request.**

Catering: The Horstead Centre cooks fresh, locally-sourced food onsite. **Full-board visitors** are required to provide allergy and dietary information for each visitor as part of our booking process. **Menus and ingredients available on request.**

Self-catering groups must have a designated cook with a food safety and hygiene certificate. They will be required to sign a self-catering agreement.

Ts and Cs - (Important Please Read) By confirming a booking with the Horstead Centre you commit to abide by our Terms and Conditions, including the payment upon receipt of an invoice of any cancellation fees.

Minimum Numbers:

- **Low season (Nov-Feb)** - 20 People for all residential visits - 12 for Activity days
- **Mid season (Mar-Apr & Sept-Oct)** - 25 people for all residential visits - 12 for Activity days
- **High season (May-Aug)** - 25 people for all residential visits - 12 for Activity days

Cancellation Policy: Cancellation fees are based on the number of people declared on booking, or our minimum number, whichever is the greater.

Cancellation fees:

- **Between booking and 12 weeks of arrival** - £100/night cancellation fee... or £50 for a cancelled Activity Day.
- **Within 12 weeks of arrival** - 25% of full fee (applicable to full-group cancellation)
- **Between 6-12 weeks of arrival** - 50% of full fee (applicable to full-group cancellation)
- **Within 6 weeks of arrival** - Full Fee (applicable to full-group cancellation and any reduction in numbers)

Payment Terms: You will be invoiced on the date of departure for the number of people declared on your booking form *or* the number of people you bring whichever is the greater. Subject to our minimum numbers, residential charges are based upon the number of people occupying the Centre and charges for activities are based upon individual activity usage. Invoices are due on presentation. **The Horstead Centre strongly recommends that all guests have appropriate insurance to cover the costs incurred by any potential cancellation or reduction in numbers.**
