Pricing:

Prices are published in October and will apply to all bookings for a 12 month period after the following March 1st.

Booking Process:

On receiving an enquiry the Horstead Centre will provide a sales estimate at the earliest possible opportunity based on your numbers and selected activities/package. If you are booking well in advance, we will hold a provisional booking for you until a sales estimate is available in October. You may accept the estimate, or decline and cancel with no penalty

Once you have accepted a booking price you enter into a contract with the Centre and commit to abide by our full Terms and Conditions, including the payment upon receipt of an invoice of any cancellation fees. We will not require a deposit.

Minimum/Maximum Numbers:

Residential Visits: (65 maximum—some flexibility)

- Low season (November, December, January, February) Minimum numbers of 25 people.
- Mid season (March, April, September, October) Minimum numbers of 30 people
- High season (May, June, July, August) Minimum numbers of 30 people

Activity Days and Sessions:

- Activity Days (All year round) Minimum numbers of 14 people. (Maximum 60+)
- Activity Sessions 10 Participants (Maximum 14 per session)

Cancellation Policy:

Cancellation fees are based on the number of people declared on booking, or our minimum number, whichever is the greater. Within 8 weeks of your booking date, cancellation fees apply to any reduction in numbers as well as cancellation of full bookings. You may adjust your numbers with no penalty up until this point.

Cancellation fees:

- Between booking and 12 weeks of arrival £100/night cancellation fee... or £50 for an Activity Day.
- Between 6-8 weeks of arrival 25% of full fee (applicable to reduced numbers and full-group cancellation)
- Within 6 weeks of arrival Full Fee (applicable to reduced numbers and full-group cancellation)

Payment Terms:

- Subject to any special terms agreed in writing between The Horstead Centre and the customer, the customer shall make payment for the full booking price upon receipt of an invoice.
- Invoices will be sent 6 weeks *prior* to each customer's visit and require payment in full no later than 14 days prior to the arrival date. The Horstead Centre shall not send payment reminders and the customer must ensure that payments are made by the relevant due dates.
- Bookings made within 8 weeks of the arrival date must be paid in full prior to arrival unless otherwise agreed with the Horstead Centre.
- Any changes to the booking that incur additional costs (additional attendees, activities etc.) will be invoiced on departure and to be settled within 30 days.
- The Horstead Centre strongly recommends that all guests have appropriate insurance to cover the costs incurred by any potential cancellation or reduction in numbers.
